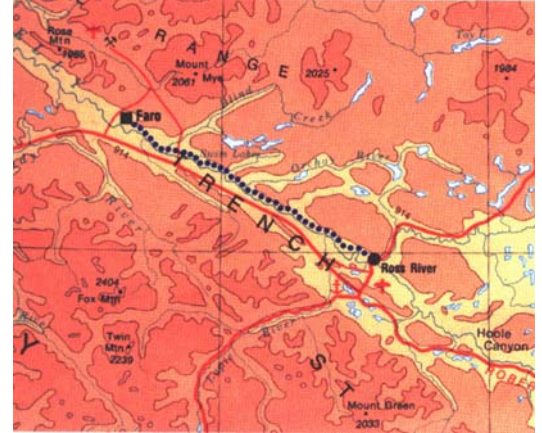

Following a traditional route along the north bank of the Pelly River, the 80 km trail commemorates the role of First Nations prospectors in the economic development of the area. The project is a partnership by the communities of Faro and Ross River and will provide the region with a major eco-tourism resource.
